6.0 Eligibility of Competitors

The Championship is open to all Malaysians, expatriates resident in Malaysia and Regional skiers and riders from the Asian IWSF affiliated national associations invited by MWSF.

7.0 Categories of Events

Novice Slalom

Girls (Under 10): any speed with entry & exit gates. Boys (Under 10): any speed with entry & exit gates. Girls (Under 15): any speed with entry & exit gates. Boys (Under 15): any speed with entry & exit gates. Slalom Women Intermediate: Start Speed 37kph. Men Intermediate: Start Speed 40kph. Women Open: Start Speed 49kph. Men Open: Start Speed 52kph. Shortboard ("Tricks" from round 2) Novice Girls & Boys (Under 10) Novice Girls & Boys (Under 15) Women Open Men Open Jump (from round 3) Novice Girls & Boys (Under 15) Women Open Men Open Wakeboard Women Novice Men Novice Women Intermediate Men Intermediate Women Open Men Open

• Ages are calculated on the 1st Jan 2010. Eg. If you are born on the 15th Jan 2000 you are over 10 on the 1st Jan 2010 and not eligible for "Under 10" category.

8.0 Entry Fees

8.1 For all categories: **RM150 per event category, RM100 for second event category and RM50 for the third**. The entry fees will entitle the competitor to one practice run on Friday (2 passes for slalom, 2 falls or 2 passes for shortboard & wakeboard), one competition run on Saturday and one competition run on Sunday as well as the following benefits:

- One event teeshirt
- Two lunch packs (Saturday & Sunday)
- Mineral water for both days
- And any other prize monies, vouchers/benefits forthcoming from the organiser/sponsor.
- MWSF trainees are entitled to 50% discount on entry fees.

8.2 Entries must be submitted with entry fees to the "Waterski & Wakeboard World Cup Sdn. Bhd." no later than 2 weeks before each round to be received by 5pm by hard copy mail. Email attachment will not be valid as we need the original signature on the entry form and the indemnity form.

8.3 Late entries will be charged a penalty of RM30 per category. Late entries may not be accepted (even if penalty is paid) if the maximum number of entries for Slalom categories exceed 30 and the maximum number of entries for Wakeboard categories exceed 30.

8.4 Late entries will close on the Friday before the event at 12noon.

9.0 Amalgamation of Events

The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate any event with another that has less than 4 entries in the manner at their discretion.

<u> 10.0 Awards</u>

For each round, each category or for each amalgamated category competitors will receive the following awards:

1st – Gold Medal

2nd – Silver medal

3rd – Bronze medal

Championship awards will be certificates for the Champion awarded after the final round of the Championship.

11.0 Cash Prizes

• The cash prizes above maybe increased or reduced in accordance with the sponsorship secured.

If categories are amalgamated, there will only be one set of cash prizes awarded. Cash prizes are only awarded provided the entry has paid up the full entry fees. Cash prizes will be paid down to 3rd provided there is at least 4 entries in the category. If the category has only 3 entries only cash prizes for 1st and 2nd are awarded.

12.0 Championship Points

Points shall be awarded for each category with 5 points for 1st, 4 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, 2 points for 4th and 1 point for 5th for each round.

13.0 Tie Breaking

For Finals score: If there is a tie for 1st place there will be a run-off for 1st. If there is a tie for 2ndor 3rd the first run (Saturday run) result breaks the tie.

For championship points at the end of the year:

If there is a tie of points the one with the higher number of wins, seconds, thirds, breaks the tie. If there is a further tie, the one with a better score for the earliest round breaks the tie.
