3.0 General Briefing Notes for Officials & Competitors:

Below are General Briefing notes for all officials & competitors entered. The Chief Judges for Waterski & Wakeboard events will conduct very brief meetings with competitors at the start dock and at times stated in the schedule above which attendance is compulsory for all competitors.

- **3.1 Safety:** The Safety Boat will have 2 swimmers and life savers on board with floating spinal board and cervical collar. As the waterski and wakeboard courses are far away from the shore, either the safety boat or the tow boat will pick up competitors who had fallen and finished their runs. Jump competitors may swim to the dock next to the jump ramp if they have finished their last jump and received no jump. For the jump event there will be 2 additional swimmers at the dock next to the jump ramp. All competitors who have fallen are to signal they are ok by showing their hand signs if they are ok.
- **3.2 Prize Giving at Podium:** The prize giving schedule stated above are provisional. All competitors shall pay good attention to P.A. System announcements for the final schedule for prize giving. All podium winners must wear the event teeshirt supplied by the organisers. Prize monies in cash shall be given at the podium presentations in envelopes.
- 3.3 Lunches: All competitors are given free lunches served at the public swimming pool upper floor glass room. Please note that lunches shall be served from 11am to latest 3pm on all 3 days of Friday 25 May to Sun 27 May. For Sat & Sun, the events are going on from 12noon to 3pm therefore all officials and competitors please take turn to eat lunch if they are not competing or officiating. Should officials need food taken to the tower please have the Chief Judges instruct the Secretariat Ms. Siti by walkie talkies. Limited lunch vouchers are available for purchase for competitors' guests, parents or friends at RM25 per head. Please kindly note that lunches are given free only to accredited officials and competitors with event tags as we do not like to run out of food like previous years.
- 3.4 Pullman Hotel Meal Rates: All competitors and Officials who are staying or not staying at the official hotel shall benefit from special meal rates at the Pullman as follows: Breakfasts RM40 nett per head, Lunch RM50 nett per head, Dinner RM60 nett per head. Please make sure you get these rates by mentioning you are from "Waterski". All who are staying at the Pullman already have breakfasts included therefore the above breakfast rates are applicable for additional pax not staying in Pullman. All occupants in Pullman shall pay all their additional meals and drinks on their own account.
- 3.5 Pullman Hotel Half Day Rate: For competitors or friends who have booked with Pullman and are checking out on Sunday, please ensure you check out by 12noon and store luggage with the concierge or in another room as late check out is not always possible. A special half day rate for check out at 6pm can be arranged through the secretariat.
- **3.6 Breakfasts:** All local officials who are not staying in Pullman and are required to be on duty before the times stated in the above event schedule shall be given free breakfasts near the start dock.
- 3.7 Mineral Water: All officials and competitors are given 4 bottles of mineral water per day.
- **3.8 Official Notice Board:** The Official Notice Board is located at the Control Tower (Judges Tower). A duplicate Notice Board shall also be at the Start Dock but please do visit the Official Notice Board at the Control Tower as often as possible to be kept informed of all schedule changes and other notices.

3.9 The daily start lists for all events shall be posted at the Official Notice Board. All competitors must be ready to ski/ride as soon as the previous competitors have finished their runs/rides.

3.10 Paid Practices: Since so many competitors are all arriving late and at the same time on Thursday, we might not be able to accommodate all requests for paid practices. All practices shall be restricted to one set per competitor of 4 passes tricks, 4 passes slalom, 3 jumps & 4 passes wakeboard per set at RM50 per set of 4 passes or 3 jumps. Competitors wishing practices are to post their names on the ski order board at the start dock when they arrive and pay the practice fees and get a receipt to show to the driver before being allowed to practice. Practices shall be done away from the competition courses in "Godzilla" or "Monkey" where the courses buoys have been set up. Practices for waterski shall be the Ski Nautique 200 or the Mastercraft X7. For wakeboard shall be the Super Air Nautique or Mastercraft X2 or the Mastercraft X7.

3.11 Tow Boats: The competition tow boats are as follows:

Waterski: Ski Nautique 200 (PS197 standby)

Wakeboard Novices: Mastercraft X7

Other Wakeboard events: Super Air Nautique 210 (X2 standby)

3.12 Event Bibs: Event bibs supplied must be worn during the competition runs and must be returned after each competition run.
